### Summary

This volunteer position contributes to RBP’s success through being staffed as the leader of all medical volunteering and medical advising. This role is critical. Safety and emergency-preparedness is a top priority at RBP. The medical director is responsible for reviewing RBP’s Medical P&P, reviewing and updating RBP medical supplies, and staffing/ maintaining a volunteer medical team. Working with the Program Manager is imperative. This volunteer roll allows all participants to get out into the wilderness in a meaningful and safe way.

### Medical Volunteer Responsibilities

- Review and advise all RBP’s Medical Policies and Procedures
- Review and update RBP medical supplies, Med-Kits
- Review All Medical Hx and reviews with Medical Volunteers
- Staff medical volunteers on hikes and other expeditions
- On-call contact during all RBP outdoor events
- Solicit WFR/WFA/CPR certification donations (free or % discount)
- Attends all RBP Volunteer Medical Orientations.
