Summary

This volunteer position contributes to RBP’s success through being staffed as the medical volunteer. This role is critical. Safety and emergency-preparedness is a top priority when we head outside. The medical volunteer is responsible for all medical communications, medical supplies, and medical decision making on the day of the event in which they are staffed. Working with the Medical Director and Program Manager is imperative. This volunteer roll allows all RBP participants to get out into the wilderness in a meaningful and safe way.

Medical Volunteer Responsibilities

- Commit to being staffed as the medical volunteer for at least 5 hikes per calendar year.
- Review safety plan and medical procedures during the briefing/debriefing at each hike/ event in which they are “staffed”.
- Distributes/collects med kits to all leaders before/after each event they are staffed.
- Attends all RBP Volunteer Medical Orientations.
