Summary

Through a climb of Mt Adams & Mt. Baker, outdoor wilderness education, gear education, gear preparations, and working with the RBP Program Manager for trip logistics, permits and overall planning, this volunteer leadership roll allows all RBP participants to get out into the wilderness in a meaningful way.

Mountaineer Lead Responsibilities

- Mountain leadership team - planning, preparing and facilitating 1 training + 2 climbs
- Commitment to Snow school training, Mt. Adams, and Mt. Baker trips
- Aids in scheduling gear room “Pick-Up” & “Drop-Offs” for participants (see schedule)
- Gear check & briefing prior to trip
- Communicates closely with RBP Program Manager and the Mountaineer Lead 2 &3
- Weekly check-in meetings in May, June, and July, or as needed.
